Afternoon - DEDICATE an Eastern Legacy National Spatial Referencing System Surveyors Monument near the site where Meriwether Lewis conducted an observation on November 23, 1806 to determine the accuracy of Dr. Thomas Walker's survey line along the parallel of latitude of 36 degrees and 30 minutes north.
