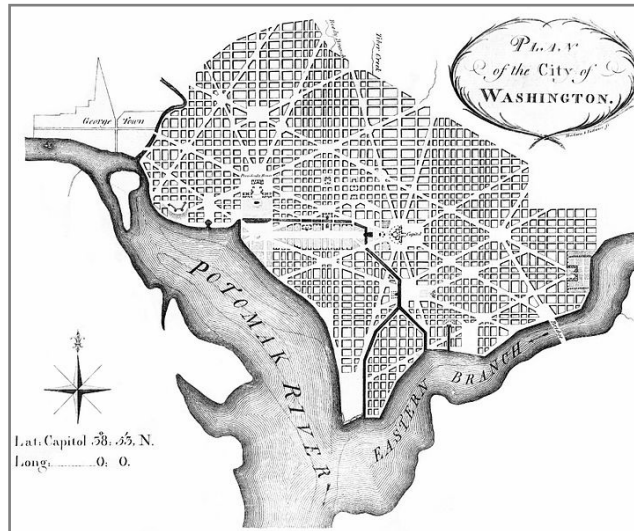

During his lifetime, Andrew Ellicott was the premier surveyor in the United States. He was called upon to perform many significant surveys such as the completion of the Mason/Dixon Line, the original survey of Washington D. C. and the survey of the line between the United States and Spanish America. He mentored Meriwether Lewis and was a professor of mathematics at West Point. These are but a few of the events from a very eventful life. Learn more about this extraordinary man who made his home in Lancaster, Pennsylvania from 1801 to 1813 in a house that miraculously still stands.

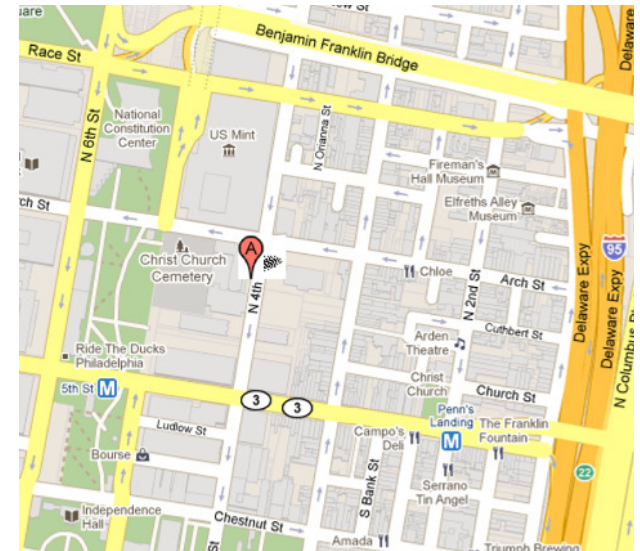
