The Presentation

On March 30, 2013 the Philadelphia Chapter of the Lewis and Clark Trail Heritage Foundation will present Albert Gallatin (in the person of acclaimed actor Ron Duquette) as he reminisces on his extraordinary life.

While best known as the longest-serving Secretary of the Treasury in our nation's history (13 years), Albert Gallatin's career as public servant is far greater and significantly more varied than that. State legislator, United States Senator, United States Representative and House Majority Leader, Minister to France, and Minister Plenipotentiary to Great Britain are some of his lesser-known titles, not to mention his role in founding New York University and inaugurating the study of modern Native American ethnology.

For our benefit and edification Mr. Gallatin will address the role the Treasury Department played in the death of Meriwether Lewis. Additionally, he will tell us about his role as Jefferson's Secretary of the Treasury in the purchase of Louisiana and the creation of the National Road. Finally, he will tell us about his role as negotiator in ending the War of 1812 through the Treaty of Ghent.
